## **Discussion Notes**

Realized Weather-Country Reports (27 Oct02 Nov. 23)	<ul> <li>With isolated light rain in some places, much of Pakistan experienced dry weather conditions.</li> <li>Bhutan and Nepal mostly experienced dry conditions with Nepal experiencing light scattered rain over some places with its northern highlands experiencing isolated snowfall.</li> <li>Bangladesh experienced isolated rain/thundershowers over some places with much of the country remaining dry. The country also experienced decreasing temperatures during the week.</li> <li>Much of Myanmar experienced scattered to isolated rain/thundershowers during the week.</li> <li>Under the influence of active currents of northeast monsoon much of Maldives and Sri Lanka experienced good amount of rain during the week.</li> </ul>	
Significant Weather Features in the region for coming week (03-09 Nov. 23)	<ul> <li>Currently a feeble western disturbance (WD) is prevailing over the northern Pakistan and the adjoining western Himalayan regions with fresh WD likely over these regions after 07 November.</li> <li>Easterly waves likely to affect the Peninsular India, Maldives, Sri Lanka and southern parts of Myanmar.</li> </ul>	
Weather Outlook (03-09 Nov. 23)	<ul> <li>Pakistan is likely to experience dry weather conditions with isolated rain/thundershowers over some places.</li> <li>Bangladesh, Bhutan and Nepal are likely to experience mainly dry weather conditions with scattered light rain over some isolated places. Also, isolated snowfall is likely over the northern highlands of Nepal and Bhutan.</li> <li>Myanmar likely to experience scattered light rain/thundershowers with isolated moderate/heavy rain/thundershowers over some places in its southern region.</li> <li>Maldives and Sri Lanka are likely to experience light/moderate with isolated heavy rain/thundershowers during the week.</li> </ul>	Extended Range Outlook (until 15 November 2023)  • A higher probability of rain over Maldives, Sri Lanka and adjoining areas towards the week ending of 15 November.

## Ocean Watch Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (27 Oct.-02 Nov. 23) No significant events experienced during the week. Forecast for the coming week (03-09 Nov. 23) Rough seas likely over the oceans and coastal areas of Maldives, Sri Lanka and adjoining coastal areas of Bay of Bengal during the week.
